Where can I get more information?

Visit one of our Welcome Centers located in the south end of the foyer in Building C. Our Welcome Center Staff can direct you to a small group Bible Study or can assist you in finding answers to questions about getting connected here at First Baptist.

What is available for children?

We have special activities in Bible Study and worship designed for infants - grade 5 during each of our worship services. Welcome Center staff, located in Building D for infants - kindergarten and in Building C for grades 1-5, can help you find your child's room. Parents of children in Building D will receive a pager number. How can I have a relationship with Jesus Christ?

How Do I Receive Christ?

- Admit your sin (I am a sinner).
- Turn from your sin (repent).
- Believe that Jesus Christ died for you on the cross and rose from the grave.
- Through prayer, invite Jesus Christ to come in and control your life through the Holy Spirit (Receive Him as Lord and Savior).
