



Frequently Asked Questions

Where can I get more information?

Visit one of our Welcome Centers located in the south end of the foyer in Building C. Our Welcome Center Staff can direct you to a small group Bible Study or can assist you in finding answers to questions about getting connected here at First Baptist.

What is available for children?

We have special activities in Bible Study and worship designed for infants - grade 5 during each of our worship services. Welcome Center staff, located in Building D for infants - kindergarten and in Building C for grades 1-5, can help you find your child's room. Parents of children in Building D will receive a pager number. Please check on your child in his or her classroom if you see your pager number appear on the digital displays located in the Worship Center.

Where can I find a recording of today's sermon?

How can I have a relationship with Jesus Christ?

- Through prayer, invite Jesus Christ to come in and control your life through the Holy Spirit (Receive Him as Lord and Savior).
